Title: Legally Qualified Chairs Terms and Conditions

Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Quality of Service

Executive Summary:

The Police (Conduct) (Amendment) Regulations 2015 requires the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) to hold a register of Lawyers who satisfy certain judicial appointment eligibility conditions, these Lawyers are known as Legally Qualified Chairs (LQC). The LQC will Chair Police Misconduct Hearings in cases of allegations of gross misconduct by police officers.

The Association of Police and Crime Commissioner's Chief Executive (APACE) have recently undertaken a review of the terms and conditions awarded to LQCs and have produced a Handbook for all Police and Crime Commissioners to adopt.

The handbook does recommend an increase in professional fees which are in line with the Home Office fees payable to Legally Qualified Chairs of Police Appeal Tribunals.

The Police and Crime Commissioner is asked to approve adopting the LQC Handbook.

Recommendation:

Financial – Daily rate for chairing Hearings increased to £511.56 and maximum preparatory rate increased to £1050.00.
