Executive Summary:

The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 states that the Police and Crime Commissioner must appoint a person to be responsible for the proper administration of the Commissioner's financial affairs (referred to as the Commissioner's Chief Finance Officer).

This position was previously undertaken by a joint resource between the Police and Crime Commissioner and the Chief Constable, however following advice from the Wales Audit Office and the Police and Crime Panel, in the interests of transparency and accountability a decision has been made to split the two roles.

The detail and specific responsibilities of the two Chief Finance Officer roles (one for the Chief Constable and one for the Police and Crime Commissioner) are outlined within the Corporate Governance Framework.

Following an independent job evaluation process, both Chief Finance Officer roles were deemed to attract a salary of £63,714 - £68,001.
