Dear Home Secretary,

As required within Section 55(5) of the Police Act 1996, I write in response to the inspection undertaken by Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary, "Regional Organised Crime Units: A review of capability and effectiveness".

I note the report and recommendations, in particular the requirement for all forces to publish an action plan that sets out how it will maximise the use of ROCU capabilities, minimise duplication at force level and ensure that the shared use of ROCU resources are prioritised between regional forces.

Dyfed-Powys Police has established a Strategic Policing Requirement Board, which covers the force response to Serious and Organised crime as one of the six Strategic Policing Requirements. Through this Board, I will work with the Chief Constable to ensure that the report is considered and action plan fully implemented.
