#### Request

I request the following information under FOI Act 2000:

- 1. Claims by your PCC this week stating that Dyfed-Powys is the safest policing area in the country how has he come to this conclusion?
- 2. What measures is he using to determine this?

### Clarification:

The applicant was contacted and asked: "When and where exactly this statement was read as the PCC makes a number of statements and wants to ensure that we are responding specifically to the statement that you (Mr Morgan) are referring to in your request." The applicant responded as follows: "Mr. Salmon should know which one it was – he was quoted on Twitter last week as saying that Dyfed-Powys is the safest place and that officer numbers have increased; I cannot remember the exact date, I guess it was the day of my request or the day before. I'd like you to honour my request for the information under FOI please."

# Responses 1 & 2:

I can confirm that the Dyfed Powys Police and Crime Commissioner does hold the information requested, as detailed below:

On 14<sup>th</sup> August 2015, a press release was issued by the OPCC based on the information available in the Police and Crime Commissioners' Annual Report for 2014/15. The press release included the statement: "Carmarthenshire, Ceredigion, Pembrokeshire and Powys are safer than ever before. Recorded incidents have fallen four percent since 2013-14. Dyfed-Powys has the second lowest number of recorded crimes in England and Wales per head." Copies of both the press release and the Annual Report are available on the hyperlinks detailed below:
