In the last 12 months the office has undergone a restructure which has included some changes to staff roles and responsibilities. E.g. a new post – Commissioning Support Officer was created due to the volume of work in that area. During this period there has been an increase of one staff member, a Temporary Customer Service Advisor, in the Public Service Bureau.
