Request

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, please provide me with full answers to each of the following questions about office costs.

I appreciate you will have been asked similar questions before but I am looking for specific figures on seconded officers.

1. How many members of OPCC staff are there of March 2015, and what is the current annual salary cost?
2. How many people working in your office are seconded from the local police force, rather than being on the OPCC's books, and what is the cost of their salaries?
3. Please state the rank of these workers and what their seconded role is, ie sergeant working as staff officer.

Response

Section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 places two duties on public authorities. Unless exemptions apply, the first duty at Section 1(1) (a) is to confirm or deny whether the information specified in a request is held. The second duty at Section 1(1) (b) is to disclose information that has been confirmed as being held.

I can confirm that there is information held by the Office of Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) relevant to your request as identified below.

Response 1:

On the 1st of March 2015 there were a total of 15 members of the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioners (OPCC) staff. The OPCC staff structure and annual salary bandings (which can be totalled up) is provided in the below hyperlink. Please note; the 15 members of the OPCC staff excludes the Police and Crime Commissioner and 1 x Customer Service Advisor (Police funded) post on the hyperlinked document.
