Response 1 – 10:

Section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 places two duties on public authorities. Unless exemptions apply, the first duty at Section 1(1) (a) is to confirm or deny whether the information specified in a request is held. The second duty at Section 1(1) (b) is to disclose information that has been confirmed as being held.

I can confirm that information is held by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner, the details of which are as follows:

- 1) One (1) subject access request was received and processed in the year 2014
- 2) Zero (0) subject access requests were received and processed in the year 2015
- 3) One (1) subject access request was received and processed in the year 2016
