Timing: Pressing – placement must be agreed by 30/09/18 and completed by 01/11/18

Title: Joint internship with Open University

Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Workforce

Executive Summary:

The Open University in Wales (OUIW) have offered a Student Internship opportunity sponsored by Santander. The OPCC submitted an expression of interest in participating and have been successful in being accepted as a suitable placement. The OUIW will market the opportunity to all relevant students (those who intend on graduating this summer). The student will be paid £300 per week, with the placement lasting for up to 10 weeks, with the first two weeks being funded by Santander. Weeks three to ten will also be 50% funded by Santander; the OPCC will fund the other half. The total cost to the OPCC will therefore be £1,200 for a 10 week placement.

It is intended that the student will be based with the assurance team within the office and will be focused on supporting a project of public focussed scrutiny activities over the 10 week period which will help to support the wider assurance portfolio and ensure diverse community groups are provided with the opportunity to feed into the Commissioner's scrutiny activity.

The OPCC will be responsible for the shortlisting, interview, selection, vetting, appointment and employment of the individual, with Santander providing their contribution by way of a grant.

Recommendation:

The Commissioner is asked to approve that the OPCC employ a student intern for a period of 10 weeks in collaboration with the Open University in Wales and that they be recruited using the OPCC's usual recruitment procedure.
