Title: Association of Convenience Stores' Police and Crime Commissioner Pledge

Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Keeping our Communities Safe

Executive Summary:

The Police and Crime Commissioner's response to the Association of Convenience Stores' (ACS) 2019 Crime Report in May 2019 committed to a number of actions, including to:

- 1. raise the ACS' Pledge with the Chief Constable to ensure Dyfed-Powys Police are sufficiently equipped to meet the commitments within the Pledge;
- 2. endorse and support the #AlwaysReportAbuse campaign locally to ensure shop workers feel confident to report incidents and know that they will be treated seriously by the Service; and
- 3. ensure the Community Remedy menu is reviewed during the new two-tier out of court disposal system changes and during developments of the diversionary service.

This paper seeks the Chief Constable's commitment to promoting effective police and partnership responses to shop theft and subsequently the Commissioner's approval to sign the Association of Convenience Stores' Police and Crime Commissioner Pledge.

Recommendation:

That the PCC signs the Association of Convenience Stores' Police and Crime Commissioner Pledge.
